

### MaineCF Scholarships

- Total scholarships \$4,191,428 in scholarships to over 1,100 Maine students in 2023
- Over 700 scholarship funds
- The Maine Community Foundation seeks to promote respect for all people. Through its scholarships, the community foundation supports all students regardless of their race, age, ancestry or national origin, sexual orientation, gender, physical or mental disability, religion, or geographical region within the state of Maine.
- Students are eligible regardless of their citizenship or immigration status, and we do not ask for this information in our applications.



# Types of Scholarships

- Scholarship: These are set up by organizations or donors to benefit a specific eligibility. MaineCF manages the entire process from application all the way to payment. Minimum amount to set up this type of scholarship is \$250,000
- **Agency Scholarship:** set up by a school-typically a high school. The high school manages the entire process from application to payment. MaineCF holds the funds and distributes the award amount to the school for payment. Minimum amount is \$10,000
- **Designated Scholarship:** set up by a donor to benefit a specific school or organization. MaineCF holds the funds and distributes the award amount to the beneficiary for payment. Minimum amount is \$10,000



# Eligibility

- Varies widely across our scholarship program
- Many programs benefit a specific school or region donors wish to support their former high school or the students in their area.
- Major we have scholarships that support healthcare, journalism, business, veterinary study, education, engineering, STEM the list goes on! And many do not limit the field of study!
- Memorial scholarships families of someone who has passed open scholarship funds in their honor. These scholarship funds often have a geographical requirement, or they support a student who has similar interests or goals as the person who passed.
- Adult Learners must only meet one of our eligibility criteria to be classified as an adult learner.



### Adult Learner Long-Term Scholarship

- over \$675,000 to 358 Maine adult learners last year we received roughly 500 submissions in 2023
- Awards supported 2- and 4-year college degrees, vocational and technical education, as well as certifications and licensures
- Helps Maine residents complete their education to become more employable, and to improve the quality of their life
- Uses our online application portal
- Two deadlines per year. June 15<sup>th</sup> for fall semester study and November 15<sup>th</sup> for spring semester.
- This is a RENEWABLE award we ask students to apply for renewal for each semester they attend school. This award cannot be deferred.




### Adult Learner Short-Term Award

- For programs lasting less than a full semester.
- Applicant earning <u>a certificate or workplace credential</u>, not a degree.
- The applicant will not need to renew the award to finish the program.
- Rolling deadline the committee considers applications as they are submitted. Decisions will be made within 10-14 days.
- Apply at least a month before the program begins. This award is not renewable.
- Size of the awards will depend on the individual need, but most awards are maxed at \$1,500.
- Application Deadline: Rolling. Awards are not retroactive and cannot fund programs that have already started. Make sure to apply well before your program starts.
- Uses a paper application download it from our site. Do not use old applications please use the 2024 version from the website.





- ➤ Provides personalized support to our scholars through one-on-one meetings and collaboration with the support services of our college partners





Commercial Pilot Aerial Application




Geophysicist

# 2025 Scholars

In 2025, we aim to award

1,000 scholarships

to graduates from every public high school in Maine



## **Award**

Multi-year scholarship – Up to \$20,000 total

#### 4-year college

➤ Paid at \$2,500 per qualified semester

#### Community college

➤ Paid at \$1,500 per qualified semester

Funds must be used within 6 years of the recipient's graduation date After 6 years, any remaining funds will be forfeited





# Eligibility

#### To be eligible a student must:

- > Be a 2025 graduate of one of our 134 public high schools based in Maine
- ➤ Have an SAI of 30,000 or less
- > Meet a GPA requirement
  - ➤ 4-year college = High School GPA of B- or higher as determined by the high school
  - > Community college = GPA of C- or higher as determined by the high school
- Attend college full-time the Fall semester after they graduate high school



# **GPA Verification**

When a student applies, a verification request will be sent to their high school contact

The request will ask for the student's numerical GPA and the range of the letter grade equivalent

- > A Range (A+, A, A-)
- ➢ B Range (B+, B, B-)
- > C Range (C+, C, C-)

School staff have until one week after our April 15th application deadline to verify GPAs.

# Scholarship Can Apply to Total Cost of Attendance

Cost of Attendance (COA) = the college's estimated price to attend for one year

- > Tuition
- > Fees
- Books & School Supplies
- Room and Board
- > Transportation
- > Technology
