Start with the table of contents and ask:

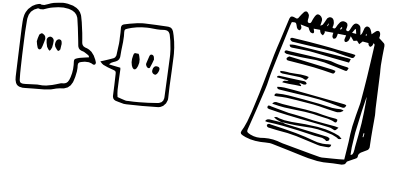
- 1 Which careers have you heard of?

- 7 Talk about your career dreams as you were growing up.



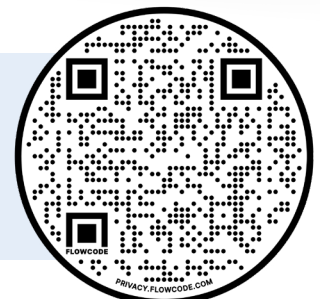
